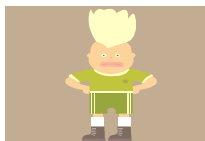


As customers of Ringwood Day Nursery we are pleased to give you the opportunity to purchase items from 'Flames' in Ringwood with a 10% discount.

Education Grant



Any child attending Ringwood Day Nursery is entitled to Early Years Education funding from the term after their third birthday.

Early years education is provided to all children who are old enough as 2 ½ hour sessions. Every child is entitled to a maximum of 5 sessions per week during the Hampshire school terms. Two sessions may be claimed in one day if your child attends for Full Days

Once your child becomes old enough, you will be asked to complete a claim form at the beginning of every term. The nursery then makes a claim on behalf of all the children within the setting.
