It has been a busy start to the year here at Ringwood Day Nursery. We have had a lot of new families join us recently, therefore we would like to share a little bit of information about us as 'The Day Nursery Group'.

The Day Nursery Group



The Day Nursery group was established with the purchase of its first nursery, Ringwood Day Nursery, opening in January 2005. In May 2015 Ringwood Day Nursery received the ultimate accolade from Ofsted being awarded "Outstanding in all areas", this is something we have achieved again since then in October 2019.

In January 2010 we opened Redhill Day Nursery, a 44 place setting on the outskirts of Bournemouth.

In October 2010, we took over an existing nursery in Verwood, re-naming it Verwood Day Nursery. The nursery had a homely feel, great natural light, and a huge outdoor area. Verwood was the perfect setting to add to our existing 2 nurseries, completing the set of 3 which is now known as the 'Day Nursery Group'.

The Day Nursery Group (Ringwood Day Nursery, Redhill Day Nursery and Verwood Day Nursery) all follow the same policies and procedures and share the same ethos and beliefs with 'Care for all, fun for all and learning for all' at the heart of everything we do.

All of the settings provide food of a high standard, supporting our belief that a good diet is essential for happy and healthy children. Each nursery has a vegetable garden where the children can really begin to have an understanding of where their food comes from.

The nurseries themselves have a close relationship with each other and we believe in sharing the expertise of our staff teams. With monthly managers meetings and the sharing of staff skills between settings, we work closely together to reflect on our practices and develop continuous plans for quality improvement and development.

Remember if you refer a friend, family member or colleague to us and the family mentions you on the booking form you will receive £100 credit on your invoice as a thank you. Terms and Conditions:

- The new child's booking is a minimum of two sessions per week on a full time (51 weeks a year) contract
- \cdot The registration form is completed with your name on it as the referrer. Once the new child has attended Ringwood Day Nursery for 3 full months the £100 reward will be credited to your account in the 4th month.

The children have been showing they are becoming more independent and interested in the care routines, so we worked on this by promoting care routines during their play. The children have brushed the doll's hair and taken part on a teeth cleaning activity, where they use a toothbrush to clean a smiley mouth. We've been encouraging the children to wipe their faces after meals and they're always so proud to have



tried doing it themselves even if they are still a little messy!








Pear Room...

and by looking at a variety of books based on The Very Hungry Caterpillar book and animal encyclopaedias. The children have also been playing games related to this such as The Very Hungry Caterpillar dominoes.











Pre School...








Pre-school children enjoyed learning about the different events at the start of spring. For Valentine's Day they used real flowers to create their own bouquet to give to someone they love.
